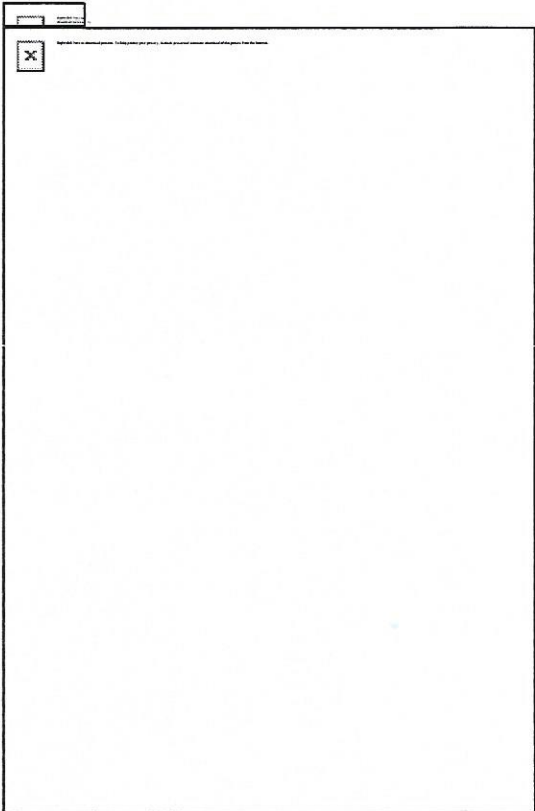

GAMA SAFETY REPORT

Best Practices 2nd Edition On Site Construction Safety

The purpose of the Best Practices guide is to help prevent injuries through education, training, advocacy and partnership.

The guide was developed in partnership with the following, Calgary Construction Association, The City of Calgary and Alberta Occupational Health & Safety, and was formed as a result of concern over construction incidents. The Main focus guide was to raise awareness of the various hazards and conditions at and adjacent to construction sites. Being that construction activities occur in diverse environments, pre-planning for public safety is essential.

In order to achieve due diligence, GAMA Members should be responsible to implement systems and procedures to ensure the safety of their employees and the General public.

Tasks should be carried out by competent staff at all times who have received proper training.

This Guide is broken down into four components:

Section 1: Hoarding of Construction and/or Demolition sites

Section 2: Managing Vehicular and Pedestrian Traffic Adjacent to Construction Sites

Section 3: Lifting and Hoisting Operations

Section 4: Securing Construction Materials and Equipment On-Site
